- Active development is going on in FLUME-728 branch.
 - FLUME-728 branch has gone through two milestones "NG alpha 1" and "NG alpha 2". A total of 50 issues have been fixed in these two
 milestone.
 - A release is being planned for 1.0.0-alpha-1 based on this branch.
- An inaugural Flume Meetup was held in New York on November 9, 2011 which was attended by 40 users and developers.
