

Status Report - May 2016

DESCRIPTION

Apache Flume is a distributed, reliable, and available system for efficiently collecting, aggregating, and moving large amounts of log data to scalable data storage systems such as Apache Hadoop's HDFS.

RELEASES

- * The last release of Flume was version 1.6.0, released on May 20, 2015.
- * No other releases are planned at this time.

CURRENT ACTIVITY:

- * A total of 30 issues have been filed, and 16 issues have been resolved between the period starting February 6, 2016 and May 4, 2016.
- * Approximately 424 messages were exchanged on the dev list in the past three months, while a total of 127 were exchanged on the user list in this period.

COMMUNITY

- * The last time a new committer was added to the project was on June 19, 2015.
- * The last time a new PMC member was elected for the project was on November 4, 2014.
- * Currently there are:
 - Total of 282 subscribers to the developer list
 - Total of 662 subscribers to the user list
 - Total of 26 committers
 - Total of 21 PMC members

ISSUES
