- New legislation increases transparency**  
On 1 October the new act on the disclosure of major holdings and capital interests enters into effect. This legislation increases the transparency in the holdings and capital interests in securities-issuing institutions and simplifies the disclosure process for those obliged to report.
- Budget Memorandum 2007: EMU surplus 0.2% GDP**  
The Budget Memorandum 2007 expects a budget surplus. The EMU balance will reach 0.2 per cent of GDP in 2007. The government is giving priority in the 2007 budget to further improvement of the economic structure, purchasing power, safety and youth policy.
- Tax Plan 2007: focus on labour market and income**  
In 2007 the administration will give priority to further strengthening the economic structure and purchasing power. The income tax rate will be reduced from 34.15 per cent to 33.65 per cent in the first bracket and from 41.45 per cent to 41.40 per cent in the second bracket.

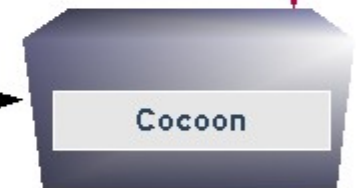
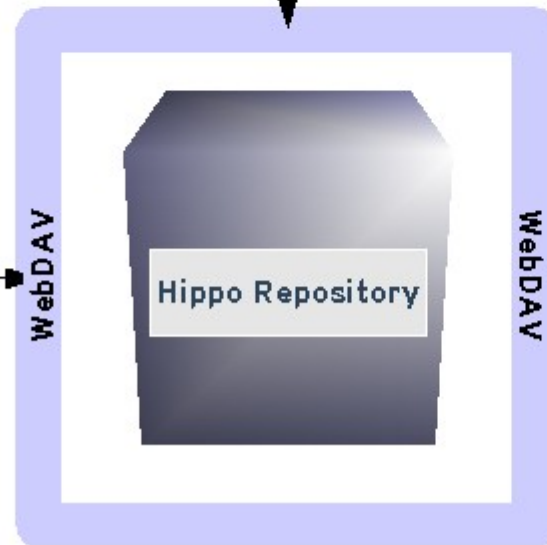
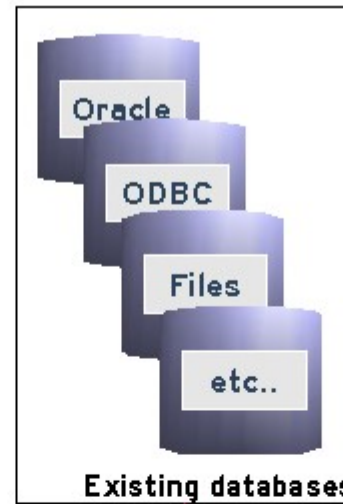
