

Spring XML Extensions

The Camel [Spring XML Extensions](#) allow you use a very concise XML syntax to describe your Camel configuration when you are using spring to wire together your application.

The following is an example of what it looks like:

        <to uri="direct:d"/>
      </otherwise>
