How to Become a Committer on the ActiveMQ Project

As outlined on [How It Works document](#) and the [ASF roles](#) defined there, we want to actively encourage folks to move from being contributors to the ActiveMQ TLP toward becoming full-fledged committers on the project. In an effort to provide more transparency on what it takes to become a committer on the ActiveMQ project, we are assembling our thoughts here. As we work through the identification of the skills and values we feel are necessary to become a committer on the ActiveMQ project, we should continue to discuss our thoughts on the dev@activemq mailing list so that everyone is able to participate.

Below is the list of some of the guidelines we believe make up a good candidate for being offered committership:

- Demonstrated ability to contribute patches/pull requests to ActiveMQ projects
- Demonstrated participation in discussions on the ActiveMQ mailing lists
- Willingness to contribute to the documentation
- Willingness to mentor and be mentored
- Helping to promote the community and this project, including outside of Apache
- Sustained interest and contribution
