Exchange Pattern

There are many different *Message Exchange Patterns* you can use in messaging. This concept is also demonstrated in WSDL and JBI's MEPs.

From there [Enterprise Integration Patterns](#) the common examples are

- [Request Reply](#)
- [Event Message](#) (or one way)

In Camel we have an [ExchangePattern](#) enumeration which can be configured on the **exchangePattern** property on the Message [Exchange](#) indicating if a message exchange is a one way [Event Message](#) (InOnly) or a [Request Reply](#) message exchange (InOut).

For example to override the default pattern on a [JMS](#) endpoint you could use this URI

```
jms:MyQueue?exchangePattern=InOut
```
