Save to home screen to create better mobile experience

This is also called "[PWA mode](#)" but from the PWA features OpenMeetings is simply using Icon, splash screen and some restrictions on the browser to hide the URL/navigation bar and fix to landscape mode (Android only). But it creates more of a Mobile native app look and feel. And improves the browser experience.



Prerequisites: Application needs to be opened in HTTPS and with a valid certificate. And in iOS you require Safari v15.x or later in order to share your camera.
