1. why: Why use OpenOffice.org
2. download: Direct download specific product only
3. support: Support area (many alternatives!)
4. extensions: get extensions (housed at OSU)
5. participating: catch-all for all kinds of participation
6. news (top navigation bar): news, manually edited
7. download: Complete download page (user, developer version, other information)
8. projects (top navigation bar): a complete listing of all projects
9. people: registered OO.o participants (needed for mailing list activity, etc.)
10. my page (participant login)
11. about: a page about the project

## New Site Recommendations (in discussion)

### Overview

1. Primary restructuring based on "users" vs "developers"
2. User focused areas would remain on a server designated as: openoffice.org
3. Native-language areas would remain with the "language".openoffice.org specification
4. Developer areas would be assigned to: openoffice.apache.org.

A. The new site will use the Apache CMS and Django style headers used by the CMS. All django style templates and programming are stored in the "templates" folder.
