Setup

To build a wicket web application you need to understand the WAR-file layout and what the WEB-INF/lib is all about, otherwise you should go read the In troduction on Java web applications.

Quick start

The following JAR-files are the bare minimum needed in WEB-INF/lib to develop a wicket application:

wicket-1.3.0.jarslf4j-api-1.4.2.jarslf4j-jdk14-1.4.2.jar

The use of Servlet filters in the web.xml configuration is explained here.

That's it, now go kick the tires!
