Status Report - May 2015

DESCRIPTION

Apache Flume is a distributed, reliable, and available system for efficiently collecting, aggregating, and moving large amounts of log data to scalable data storage systems such as Apache Hadoop's HDFS.

RELEASES

- * The last release of Flume was version 1.5.2, released on November 18 2014
- * Work on the next release version 1.6.0 is currently underway.

CURRENT ACTIVITY

- * A total of 78 issues have been filed, and 39 issues have been resolved between the period starting February 5, 2014 and May 4, 2015.
- * Approximately 1095 messages were exchanged on the dev list in the past three months, while a total of 224 were exchanged on the user list in this period.

COMMUNITY

- * The last time a new committer was added to the project was on May 8, 2015.
- * The last time a new PMC member was elected for the project was on November 4, 2014.
