

With Squid - connect with proxy server

Many users sometime ask the issue of title to the community. So i would like to share my case in here.

1. Environment

Apache HTTPD(ver.2.2.15) + Squid(ver.3.1.10) + OpenMeetings(ver.3.0.5) all are on Cent OS(ver.6.6)

2. Setting Configuration

Apache HTTPD
httpd.conf
